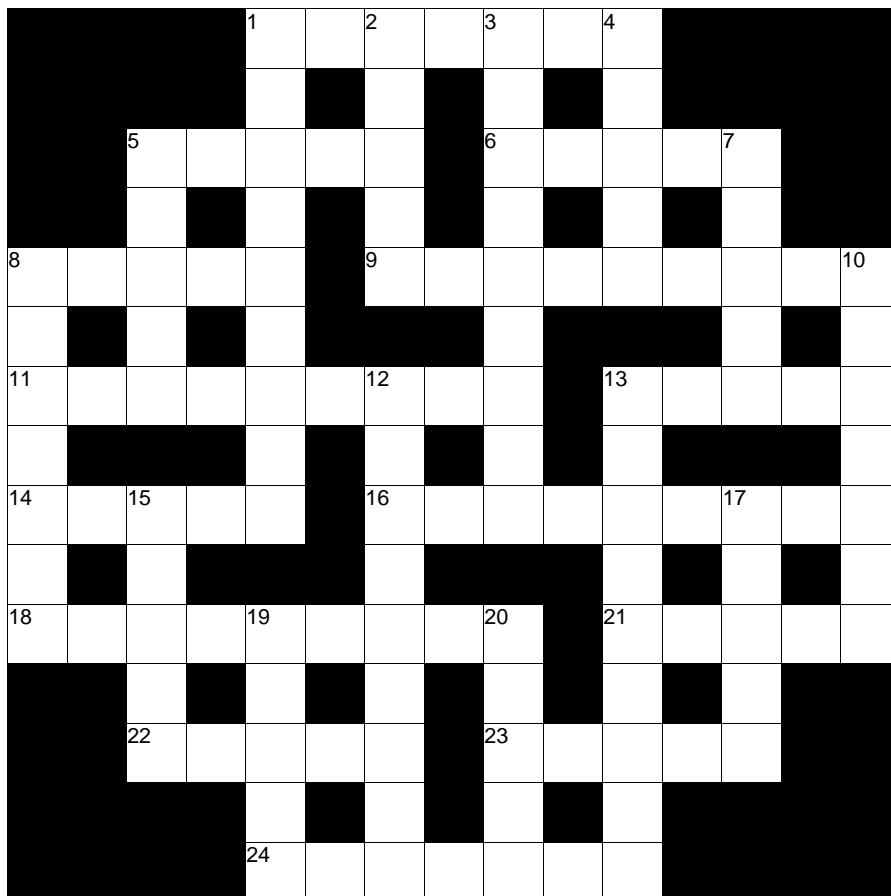

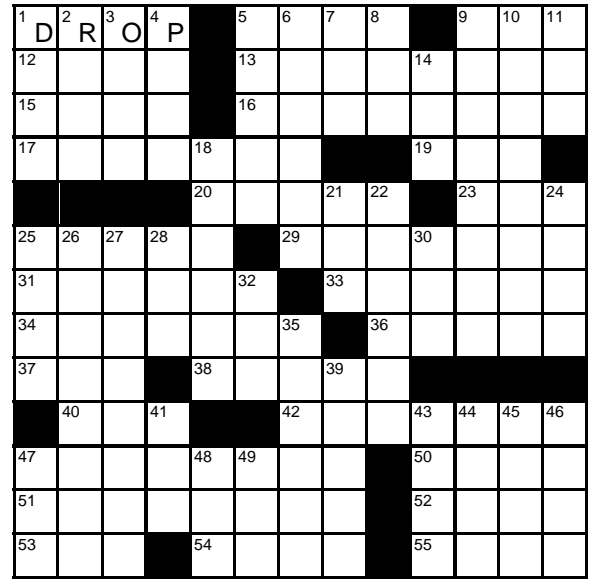
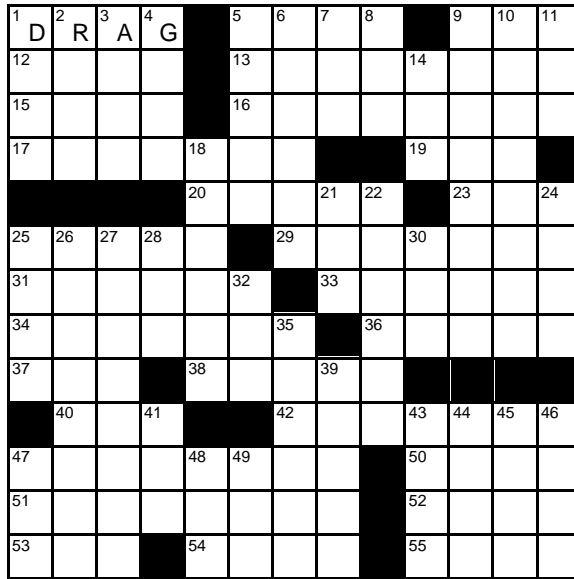


Siamese Twins – A Puzzle by Jeffrey Harris
